The Roads

- Use the pullouts to let others pass you.
- Gas up! Gas stations are few and far between on Highway 1
- Give at least three feet of clearance when passing bicyclists.
- · Stick to main roads, avoid GPS suggestions to take back roads.

Communication

- Cell phone service is spotty (at best) on the coast. • Most locals can point to areas with good coverage.






Point Arena-Stornetta Unit of the California Coastal **National Monument**


