- Stick to main roads, avoid GPS suggestions to take back roads.

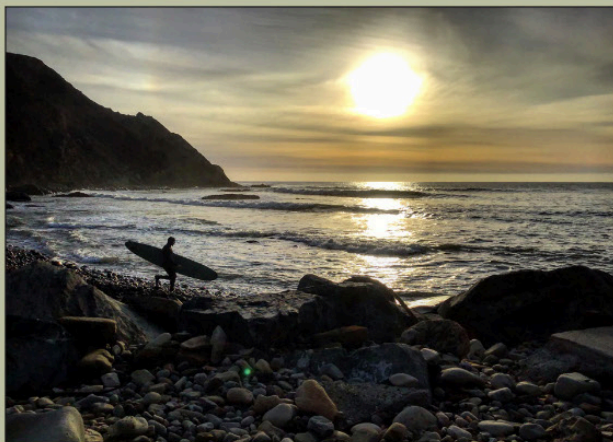


Communication

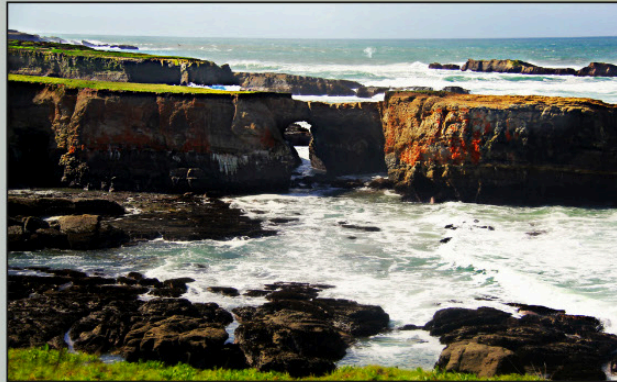

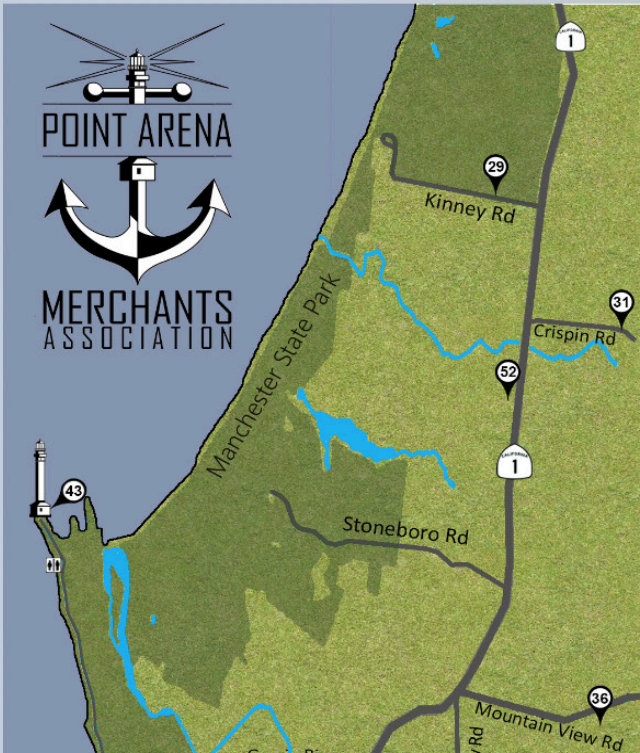


Downtown Point Arena

Moat Creek Hiking Trail

Mile marker 12.88. Walk the bluff trail loop. At low tide the trail connects to a beach walk from Moat Creek to Schooner Gulch.
